We care about everyone who works for us and want you to have a work environment that is as safe and good as possible. We are convinced that injuries, work-related illnesses and mental ill health can be prevented.

You are an important part of contributing to that.

We have rules to protect ourselves

We want to create accident-free and healthy workplaces for everyone. We believe that the best way to do this is by increasing the proportion of safe behaviours and safe work practices. Here, we need to assist one another. Always take action if you see risky behaviour or risky situations. Dare to speak up! Our actions are crucial to our own safety and the safety of others.

Before visiting one of our facilities, you must have completed a site-specific safety briefing. During this briefing, you will receive information about, for example, the local traffic plan and where to find first aid equipment.



Rules for personal safety equipment

High-visibility clothing within Heidelberg Materials' facilities must be class 3. Helmets, safety shoes and safety glasses are also required (see below).

You should make sure you know what rules apply at the workplace you are visiting. When unloading at the customer's premises, the customer's regulations always apply.

Requirements for protective equipment:

- Approved helmet with three-point chin strap in accordance with EN397.
- Safety glasses in accordance with EN166.
- High-visibility upper body clothing, minimum class 2.
- High-visibility trousers, minimum class 2.
- Ankle-high safety shoes.

If necessary:

- Gloves, hearing protection and respiratory protection.
